The proposed materials mark-up percentage for services and materials purchased by Contractor is _____ percent.

The bid format is for the Respondent to charge a percentage mark up for all items purchased from cabling to switchgear, to power transformers, to subcontracted work.

* The time estimate is based on an engineering-intensive project and the grant amount. It is recognized that as the project scope becomes clearer, these estimates may be either high or low. It is also recognized that a range of engineering experienced individuals will be involved. The unit bid price should reflect the anticipated average hourly cost of the personnel assigned to do the work.

** It is anticipated that experts will need to be temporarily working at the site. The Municipality is asking for a unit price proposal per full workday to cover per diem expenses. This is to include

vehicle, airline, hotel, meals, and any other expenses associated with moving and hosting temporary workers. This bid item assumes 600 temporary worker-days. Actual payment will be based on number of full workdays, defined as working 8 or more hours, and be tracked by the project inspector. Partial workdays will not be separately compensated.
