QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

ITB #2023B017 Addendum #1, dated February 17, 2023

1. Will there be any dump site for materials?

The Contractor is responsible for the transportation of all sweeping debris, within the contracted area, in accordance with all municipal, state, and federal requirements. No temporary storage sites for sweeping debris is allowed within the municipal rights of way. The MOA will require disposal of street sweepings at designated municipal owned sites during the sweeping season.

All Materials must be dumped at the MOA designated sites.

2. Will Water be provided if Hydrants are closed?

The Contractor is responsible for providing his/her own water for all activities. MOA does not begin residential sweeping until hydrants are opened by AWWU.

3. What is the Equipment Required? The provided list does not seem adequate for the Work Required.

The Contractor shall provide and maintain during the entire period of the Contract, a fleet of equipment to meet the performance requirements of the contract, to include;

- 1 or more Mechanical Sweeper(s)
- 1 or more Vacuum Sweeper(s)
- 1 or more Sidewalk Sweeper(s)/Broom(s)
- 1 or more Flushers Truck(s).

Fall Sweep is to be completed by Oct. 15th usually the NTP is given on or about Sept 15th it is up to the contractor to make sure they have enough equipment to complete the task in that amount of time leaving the assigned streets "visually clean". The spring sweep is up to 200 lane miles with spring sweeping period ending on June 15th again the contractor must have enough equipment to bring streets to a "visually clean" standard. The NTP in the spring is usually given after AWWU opens the hydrants for use.

4. Is Backflushing Required?

The Contractor shall provide Annual Street and Sidewalk Sweeping Services. The actual work is to be performed between April 1st and October 15th and shall include the sweeping of designated arterial, collector, commercial, residential, and industrial streets as detailed by the Sweeper Units and Street Sector area maps attached. Services to include; Spring Residential Sweep up to 200 lane miles "as needed", a Fall Residential Sweep of Units 2 and 4. These Units will be broken into Sectors, (see attached exhibits). In conjunction with sweeping of streets; all sidewalks shall be watered down, and all debris will be swept into the street. All areas swept shall then be back flushed with a high pressure flusher truck.
