Addendum #1, dated March 10, 2023

Question 1: I want to know if are we going to have some security guarantees during our operations hours?

Answer 1: The security of all citizens is a priority of law enforcement. The Citizens Action Police (CAP) Team is aware of the problems and is planning on having a larger presence in downtown Anchorage.

Question 2: If can we have assistance from any of the agencies (APD/ASP/DOWNTOWNPARTNESHIP)? When I say assistance, I'm talking about drunk people causing trouble in public areas such as parks and sidewalks.

Answer 2: Anchorage Safety Patrol (ASP) should be the first organization contacted if you encounter a drunk person causing trouble in a public area. ASP dispatch can be reached at 907-343-4006. ASP operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. If the person in question is being violent or threatening violence call ASP at 907-373-4006 and Anchorage Police Department (APD) at 9-1-1.

Anchorage Downtown Partnership (ADP) Ambassadors walk all 120 block of the downtown improvement district every day. One of their responsibilities is to support individuals needing emergency or behavioral health services. Winning bidders will be invited to a Teams call with ADP to discuss courses of action and resources that are available. The Teams call will be held on Monday March 20, 2023 at 9:00am.

Question 3: What is the procedure when we experience previously mentioned situations according by our rights?
