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Potential Proposers' Questions and Answers

Q: Is there an on-site work requirement, or can all work be performed remotely?

A: There is no on-site work requirement.

Q: Are there any current incumbents performing similar work?

A: Yes, there are two vendors that hold the current GIS term contracts.

Q: Is a wet signature required on the original copy of the RFP provided?

A: Proposers may use a wet signature or a DocuSign signature on the original version of the proposal they submit as required by Section 2.5 of the RFP.

Q: What are the specific components of the GIS Enterprise? (AGOL, # of Servers, Databases, Portal, etc)

A: AWWU primarily uses ArcMap, ArcCatalog, ArcPro, ArcPortal, and AGOL. Other enterprise components are used to support these primary applications or as needed by the utility. We have a total of nine (9) servers primarily used by GIS.

Q: Are there any non-ESRI applications that are part of workflows and/or integrations?

A: Yes. AWWU's CMMS and AMIS are non-ESRI applications. In addition the utility uses SafeFME integration software. Other non-ESRI applications may be identified as workflows and integrations progress.

Q: Will you please identify which systems you use for CMMS and AMIS?

A: AWWU's current CMMS is IBM Corporation's Maximo version 7.6. AWWU's current AMIS is Kayuga Solution's IRIS version 3.6.1.2.
