The contract documents for the referenced project are clarified and amended as follows:

Responses to Bidder's Questions

Question1: Per section 4.4 Project Approach on page 16 of 19; Does the vendor need to provide a point-by-point response to 3.1, 3.2, 3.9, 3.10, 3.14, 3.15 and then provide an individual response to each of the bulleted questions listed?

Answer1: That would be acceptable, or the contractor can specifically note in their RFP response which section(s) these items are addressed in. Sections 4.4 through 4.7 list items that the review committee will be scoring the contractors on. Proposals will be evaluated on completeness and responsiveness to these criteria.

Question2: Per section 4.5 Ability to Perform, on page 16 of 19, would APD allow the vendor to include links to our financial statements or provide the attachments via a flash drive? Financial statements tend to be 100+ pages and would make the printed proposals rather large and bulky.

Answer2: APD would accept these being provided via a flash drive.

Question3: Per section 4.5 Ability to Perform, on page 17 of 19, APD is requesting "a complete list of current customers, services provided and duration of contract." We are not able to provide a complete list with the information requested due to confidentiality requirements. Would APD accept a more tailored list of customers that are similar in size and scope as the RFP, which has given us approval to be utilized as reference?

Answer3: Yes, a tailored list is suitable. A minimum of 3 customers must be provided.

Question4: Per section 4.6 Functional Capabilities on page 17 of 19, Does the vendor need to provide a point-by-point response to the sections listed?

Answer4: That would be acceptable, or the contractor can specifically note in their RFP response which section(s) these items are addressed in. Sections 4.4 through 4.7 list items that the review committee will be scoring the contractors on. Proposals will be evaluated on completeness and responsiveness to these criteria.

Question5: Per Attachment A - System Specifications, could APD please provide the exact model of radar with which you would like your in-car camera system to integrate?

Answer5: Stalker Dual / Stalker DSR 2X, Kustom Eagle 3

Question6: Per Attachment A - System Specifications, could APD further define what type of integration you would like with Stalker and Eagle radar?

Answer6: Speed Display of officer vehicle from radar, front and rear antenna speed readings of target.

Question7: Would APD prefer that the references vendors provide have the same version of technology that the vendor is proposing as their solution?

Answer7: Yes, and if possible, the references are using all the platforms that APD is looking at.

Question8: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions #4 Encryption: Regarding encryption at rest, we meet encryption at rest with AES 256. Will that satisfy this requirement?

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Answer8: Yes

Question9: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions #7 Termination and Suspension of Service: An automated and manual self-help process is available to migrate data. Will that satisfy this requirement?

Answer9: This won't be a problem as long as the migration service is made available to APD when they request it, and the service provides the manual abilities to comply with this Term. (i.e. data being permanently deleted, etc.)

Question10: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions #9 Data Dictionary: It appears we do not have a copy of the MOA's Data Modeling Standard referenced under this section, could MOU please provide us that document?

Answer10: This has been removed from the updated terms and conditions and is no longer relevant.

Question11: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions #10 Security Logs and Reports: Will our Evidence (E.com) Admin portal audit trail satisfy this requirement? Our Internal Splunk logs are not available for external distribution.

Answer11: As long as e.com allows MOA to review records that a specific user accessed over a specific period of time.

Question12: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions #13 Operational Metrics: We can provide vulnerability scan counts or findings but cannot externally distributed raw vulnerability scans/reports. Customers can scan their instance with their tools in E.com at any time, will that satisfy this requirement?

Answer12: This will satisfy the requirement.

Question 13: Will there be applicable site visits? We want to see the location of the communication equipment and vehicles. Standard for us to see locations of installations.

Answer13: At this time there will not be site visits offered. Once the review of the proposals has taken place and the proposals are short-listed, up to 3 contractors will be invited on site for an additional interview/demo.

Question14: Will the contractor do the installation of equipment in vehicles?

Answer14: We expect the contractor to work with our installation team and train our installers.

Question15: Is there a preference for contractors who have Fed Ramp Cloud Security?

Answer15: Yes, the APD would prefer to enter into contract with a vendor who is FedRamp compliant.

Question16: Per Attachment C: Municipality of Anchorage Cloud and/or Offsite Hosting Specific Terms and Conditions 2b) Data Protection: Vendor uses non-content data to "(b) provide, develop, improve, and support current and future Vendor's products and related services;". To further clarify, Vendor defines "Non-Content Data" as data, configuration, and usage information about Agency's Vendor Cloud Services tenant, Vendor Devices and client software, and users that is transmitted or generated when using Vendor Devices. Non-Content Data includes data about users captured during account management and customer support

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activities. Non-Content Data does not include Agency Content (Vendor defines "Agency Content" as " data uploaded into, ingested by, or created in Vendor Cloud Services within Agency's tenant, including media or multimedia uploaded into Vendor Cloud Services by Agency. Agency Content includes Evidence but excludes Non-Content Data. " Is this section intended to prevent Vendor from sharing the data with a third party? Or is it to prevent Vendor's internal use of the data to provide, develop, improve, and support current and future Vendor products and related services?

Answer16: It is intended to prevent the vendor from sharing the data with a third party.

Question17: Would a site walk of the facilities be allowed? We would like to see the Interview Rooms and the mobile fleet or an example of the police cruisers for installation costs (as an option per conference).

Answer17: A site walk through will only be allowed once the initial review of proposals has taken place and a short list has been created. We have provided additional information on the interview rooms and the fleet. APD has several orders active for new vehicles (Ford Explorers). We anticipate these new vehicles (approximately 40) replacing the oldest vehicles in the fleet.

Question18: APD expects single sign-on controls, two factor authentication. What is APD currently using for network logins/SSO? (i.e. Windows local AD, Azure AD? Okta?)

Answer18: Azure AD
