# To Municipality of Anchorage residents transported by Chugiak Volunteer Fire Department (CVFD)

If you are a resident of the Municipality of Anchorage,

**And** you are transported by Chugiak Volunteer Fire Department ambulance,

**Then** your transport payment will be fully covered by your Medicare and/or other health insurance coverage. **The remainder of your charges will be written-off**. (*Anchorage Municipal Code 16.95.070*)

If you have no insurance, your charges will be written off.

# **HOWEVER**, for these fee adjustments to apply you must:

- 1. Provide all your insurance information to the billing agency as soon as you get your bill for the transport.
- 2. Supply all needed insurance information <u>and</u> your signature authorizing the billing agency to bill your insurance.
- 3. If you have no insurance coverage, immediately notify the billing agency in writing when you get your bill.

## Remember --

By law, no fee adjustments can be made until the billing agency verifies your insurance coverage and it is billed.

The ambulance transport bill <u>remains the responsibility of the patient</u> until the billing agency has all the necessary insurance information <u>and</u> signature authorizing them to bill. Where information is not provided to determine insurance coverage and / or authorize timely filing, the account is subject to collection by a third party collection agency.
