To Municipality of Anchorage residents transported by Chugiak Volunteer Fire Department (CVFD)

If you are a resident of the Municipality of Anchorage,

And you are transported by Chugiak Volunteer Fire Department ambulance,

Then your transport payment will be fully covered by your Medicare and/or other health insurance coverage. **The remainder of your charges will be written-off.**

(Anchorage Municipal Code 16.95.070)

If you have no insurance, your charges will be written off.

HOWEVER, for these fee adjustments to apply you must:

1. Provide all your insurance information to the billing agency as soon as you get your bill for the transport.
2. Supply all needed insurance information and your signature authorizing the billing agency to bill your insurance.
3. If you have no insurance coverage, immediately notify the billing agency in writing when you get your bill.

Remember --

By law, no fee adjustments can be made until the billing agency verifies your insurance coverage and it is billed.

The ambulance transport bill remains the responsibility of the patient until the billing agency has all the necessary insurance information and signature authorizing them to bill. Where information is not provided to determine insurance coverage and / or authorize timely filing, the account is subject to collection by a third party collection agency.
