Using the table below, please provide a sample cost for your company to fulfill the stated roles based upon the following scenario:

A 7.5 magnitude earthquake, epicentered approximately 12 miles northwest of downtown Anchorage, shook southcentral Alaska causing extensive damage to critical infrastructure and transportation corridors. Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) government buildings including police and fire stations were damaged, along with a number of medical facilities, water and wastewater treatment facilities, roads and rail lines, and the Port of Alaska. The Municipality's emergency operations center was activated for 30 days coordinating the local response, and the State of Alaska supported the operations with a State disaster declaration. The governor eventually petitioned the federal government for a federal major disaster declaration, and it was granted 14 days after the earthquake. The MOA is anticipating a significant recovery time, to include restoration of critical infrastructure, public and private properties and facilities, and economic recovery. The MOA's request to the State of Alaska for public assistance program happened almost immediately. The MOA activated their disaster cost recovery team at the same time. The initial damage assessments have come in at \$40 million.

You will be asked to provide experience in the entire scope of post disaster recovery management. This will require experience working with agencies in support of their recovery efforts under State and Federal aid programs (FEMA and Alaska DHS&EM specifically) including but not limited to those outlined in the Stafford Act. Also included by necessity will be project development, request for information completion, amendment processing, and providing professional guidance, and project close-out.
